The Carn Davidson 9 was formed at the beginning of 2010 as a collaborative project between JUNO nominated artists, trombonist **William Carn** and saxophonist **Tara Davidson**. CD9 draws on the body of compositions by its co-leaders. This collaborative project is an opportunity for both artists to reimagine their compositions for this chamber jazz instrumentation, shining new perspective on their existing repertoire. This 9-piece chord-less ensemble utilizes its seven horns as both melodic and harmonic devices, anchored by bass and drums.

The Carn Davidson 9's unique sound is made stronger by an all-star lineup of prominent Canadian artists who are all exceptional ensemble players as well as outstanding soloists. CD9 has produced two recordings; "Nine" was their debut released in 2012 and "Murphy" was released in 2017. Both recordings garnered JUNO nominations for Jazz Album of the Year.
